

Attention Testing Candidates

Pearson VUE requires every candidate entering this Pearson Professional Center to read the following and submit your acknowledgment during the admissions process:

I agree that it is my responsibility to self-isolate myself and reschedule my test if I have:

- **been diagnosed with COVID-19**
- **been in close personal contact with someone who has a confirmed COVID -19 diagnosis**
- **travelled to or been in contact with someone who recently travelled to, any of the following Affected Countries, Territory or Areas within the last 14 days; CHINA, JAPAN, TAIWAN, VIETNAM, HONG KONG, THAILAND, MYANMAR, SOUTH KOREA, MALAYSIA, AND ITALY.**
- **have flu-like symptoms, such as fever or chills and a cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath.**

By appearing to test, I certify that I do not meet any of the above criteria.

***If any of the above do apply to you, please do not enter the Pearson Professional Center today.**

Instead, contact your exam sponsor or the Pearson VUE contact center.

Pearson VUE would also like to illustrate measures in use at **Pearson Professional Centers** to reduce the potential of COVID-19 contamination or spread:

1. Wash hands: **Upon arrival at the test center**, we kindly ask you to wash your hands in the restroom. This follows the guidance from the World Health Organization and will help to keep your hands clean and prevent potential contamination.
2. Face mask: The use of medical face masks is permitted. You as the candidate can bring your own mask and wear it in the testing room. But before entering the testing room, our staff needs to inspect the mask prior to your entry in to the testing room. You are kindly asked to follow the instructions of our test administrators and follow the exam security check-in procedures.
3. Hand sanitizer: You will notice **hand sanitizer** placed throughout the test center for both candidate and staff to use. Our staff will advise you to use **hand sanitizer** before they conduct admission steps such as taking your palm scan, asking you to sign your name on the signature pad and before entering the testing room.
4. Kleenex/Hand tissue: Upon entering the testing room our staff will offer you tissue. Per the World Health Organization guidance please cover the nose and mouth in case of sneezing or cough.
5. After **each exam session ends**, our staff will **clean** each workstation, keyboard, mouse, headsets, pens, and locker keys with disinfectant products to ensure a clean & hygienic environment for our candidates.
6. After **each admission session**, our staff will **clean** the admission desk, proctor desk, equipment and testing items with disinfectant products.
7. We hope with the above measures we can ensure a clean & hygienic testing environment. We'd like to thank you in advance for your support and cooperation!

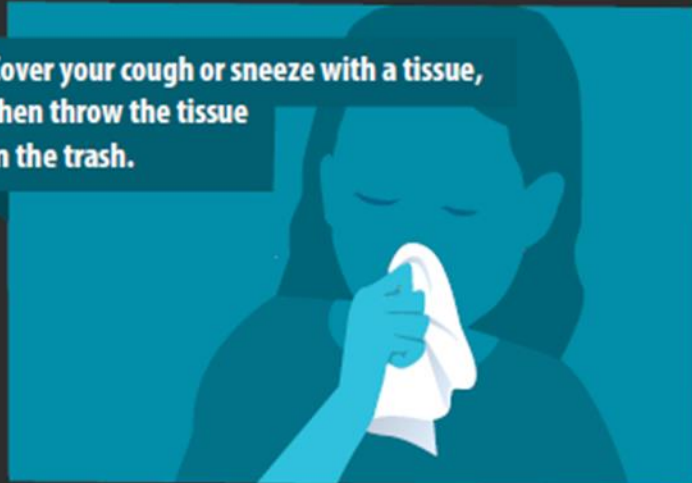
STOP THE SPREAD OF GERMS

Help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases like COVID-19.

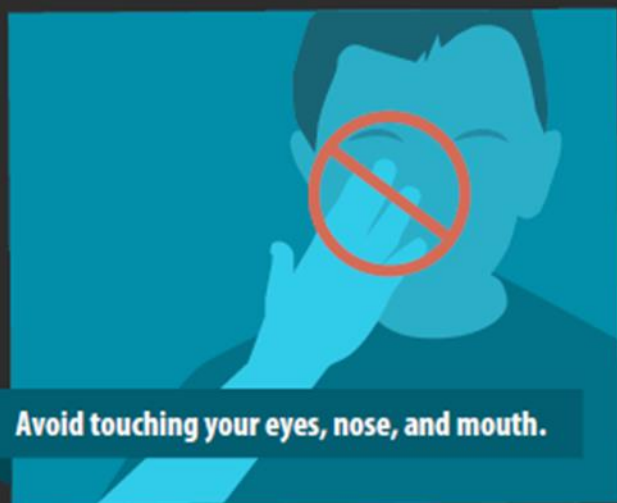
Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
